Organised by the International Society of Medical AI, the symposium brings together clinicians, scientists, ethicists, legal scholars, regulators, patient representatives, trainees, healthcare leaders and technical contributors to examine responsible medical AI. The programme is centred on clinical judgement, patient safety, ethics, governance, validation, education, institutional readiness and implementation. ISMAI 2026 is clinician-led and vendor-neutral, with scientific independence and patient-centred governance as core principles.

ISMAI 2026 is the International Symposium on Medical AI, taking place in Florence, Italy, on 3-4 December 2026 at Aula Magna CTO, AOU Careggi. The editorial theme is The Renaissance of Clinical Intelligence. Organised by the International Society of Medical AI, the symposium is designed as a clinician-led, vendor-neutral forum for serious discussion of artificial intelligence in medicine. Its focus is not only technical development, but also the clinical, ethical and institutional conditions required for responsible use. The programme addresses foundations of medical AI, real patient pathways, validation, patient safety, clinical judgement, governance, philosophy of medicine, education and professional formation. ISMAI 2026 welcomes clinicians, researchers, trainees, healthcare leaders, ethicists, legal scholars, regulators, patient representatives and technical contributors whose work engages with safe, accountable and clinically meaningful medical AI. Abstracts are invited across clinical implementation, validation, governance, patient safety, education, clinical decision-making, ethics, hospital readiness, technical work with clinical relevance and philosophy of medicine. The symposium positions Florence as a setting for renewed attention to observation, judgement and responsibility in medicine. Official information, including programme, abstracts, registration, venue, governance and CME/CPD status, is maintained at florence.ismai.org.

Editorial theme

The Renaissance of Clinical Intelligence frames ISMAI 2026 as a meeting about judgement as well as technology. The symposium uses Florence as a setting for renewed attention to observation, interpretation, evidence, safety and professional responsibility in medicine.

Do not claim endorsement, sponsorship or media coverage unless formally documented.
